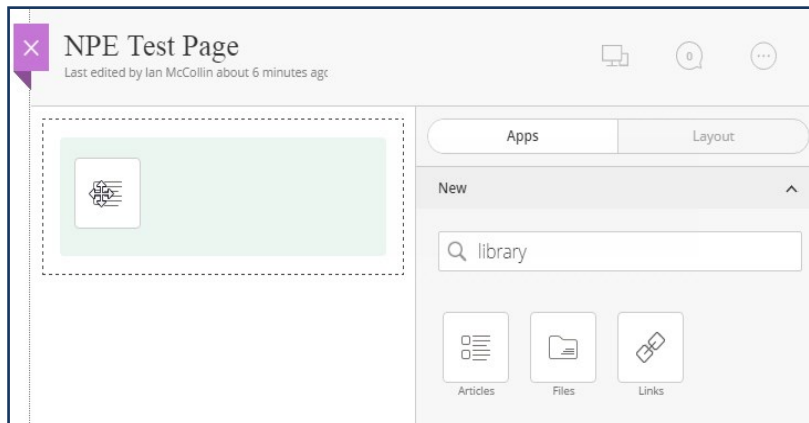

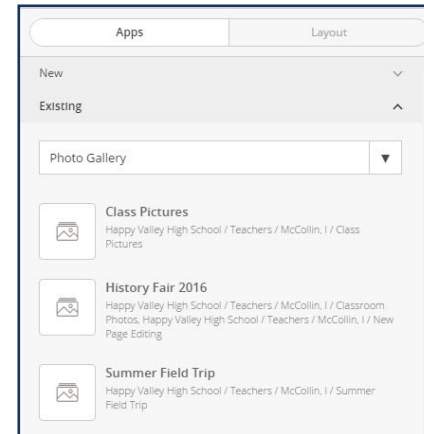
ADD NEW APPS

- Drag an app onto the page—when you see shading, drop it.
- Use the Search field to filter available apps—here library apps.



ADD EXISTING APPS

- Expand Existing.
- Select an app type from the drop-down list.

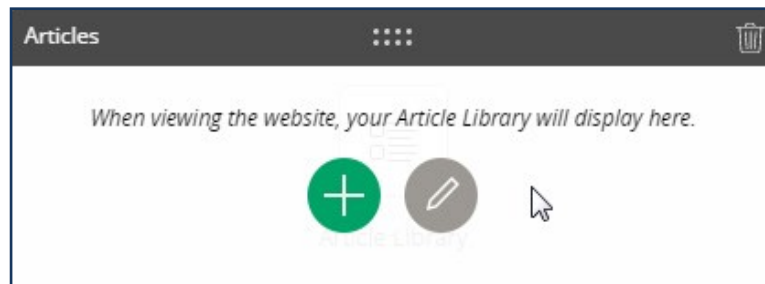


- Drag an app from the list onto the page—when you see shading, drop it.

EDIT APPS

Mouse over the app.

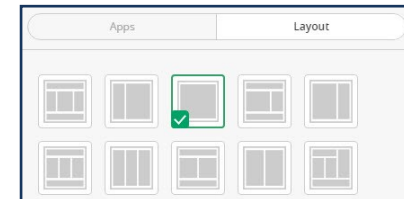
- Click the Plus icon to add a record.
- Click the Pencil icon to edit a record.



- Click the Garbage Can to remove the app from the page.
- Click the Title bar—hold—and drag the app to a different location on the page.

LAYOUT TAB

Use the Layout tab to see and select available page designs.

- Click Preview to see how your page looks on mobile and desktop screens.
- Click Pending Comments to see the Visitor Comments dialog.
